What?

The term sustainability has been in common use for some time and is also used in different contexts.

Models of sustainable development are inspired by respect for nature and people: limiting environmental impact, using the earth's resources responsibly and breaking down barriers between all the people on the planet.

To save the world, we need to start applying the concept of sustainability from us and our homes, from our small daily actions. And that is why, as part of our project, we want to promote attitudes and actions that look at sustainability as a whole: environmental, economic and social.



Why?

Sustainability is an act of responsibility and commitment that each of us can take on to save the environment and take care of the people who will come after us.



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Sustainable accommodation

Encourage the use of eco-friendly accommodation options, such as hostels or hotels that have implemented sustainable practices. For this, partners will seek alliances with sustainable service providers that promote sustainable practices in their operations and supply chain.

Low-carbon transportation

Encourage participants to travel to and from project meetings using low-carbon transportation options such as public transportation, cycling or carpooling and also by implementing practices such as adopting electric or hybrid vehicles.



Recycling policies

When purchasing materials or services for your project, choose environmentally friendly and sustainable options, products with reduced packaging and/or recyclable. This includes implementing recycling programmes for paper, cardboard, plastic and other materials in the office through the three Rs: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.

Organic purchasing

Purchase, during all project activities, products that are as far as possible 0 km or from small local realities, and use, as far as possible, natural products for cleaning and care of workplaces.





Purchasing green technologies

Using sustainable technologies, such as solar or wind power, in meetings and activities to reduce its dependence on fossil fuels, or favouring energy-efficient equipment.



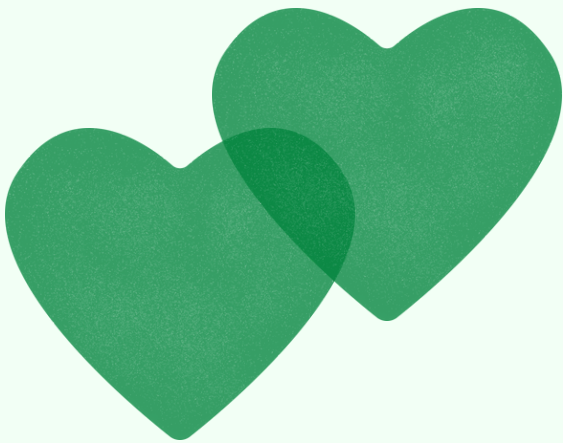
Promotion of remote working

Encourages online meetings, including through members of the same national team, to reduce the amount of travel and promote the use of digital formats for reading and daily work.



Education and awareness

Use the project as an opportunity to promote environmental awareness and education among the project participants, the employees and wider community. This includes conducting talks, part of workshops and training programs on sustainability-related topics.



Environmental impact assessment

Evaluate the environmental impact of the project and services to identify opportunities for improvement and reduction of its environmental impact.
